## **Our Farewell to The Revd Robert Simpson**

Robert's formal time with us ended on 29<sup>th</sup> February, and the Benefice said its goodbyes to him at the end of his last service, which had taken place in Cranborne church on 11<sup>th</sup> February. He thanked us for our generous gift, and for our fellowship and support during his seven years of ministry here. It was a well-attended occasion. Everyone present felt a sense of ending – but also of beginning, as Robert prepared himself for his new ministry in Wales, and our thoughts turned to the uncertainties of 'interregnum' while we are without a Rector.

Robert had joined the then Quintet Benefice in October 2017. He was resuming his life as a priest after some years as a teacher in Devon, following the ending of his marriage. He gained a reputation for sermons which were well researched and accessible, and as a priest who took his church duties very seriously. But all too soon, Covid arrived, and with it the closure of all churches – shamefully, even to their clergy – which meant a lengthy hiatus in our normal patterns of worship. Robert maintained a weekly on-line service of Holy Communion, which helped to keep the benefice together in those trying times for us all.

The lockdowns came to an end, and with them the decision to enlarge the Quintet with the Gussages, to form the Knowlton Circle Benefice in 2022. This meant another period of change and adjustment, which is in effect still continuing, and which Robert, while welcoming it, found challenging. Nevertheless, he created the new benefice, and thereby laid the foundations for the longer-term future of worship and mission in these Dorset parishes.

He will be remembered as a kindly but very private person, who avoided discord but was dutiful in his church work, and who 'knew his stuff'. His cycling exploits were a matter of legend. He had long considered a move to the Church of Wales for family reasons, and accepted the post of Vicar of Rhayader in mid-Wales. Here he becomes part of a larger team of clergy serving an area of mid-Wales, with responsibility for Rhayader itself and six neighbouring parishes.

In saying 'farewell' we wish Robert every fulfilment and happiness in his new post. His record here will, in the fullness of time, speak for itself. We thank him for his time with us, and wish him 'Godspeed' as he settles in to his new life in Wales.

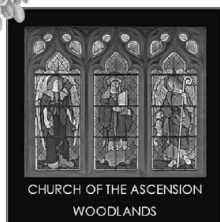

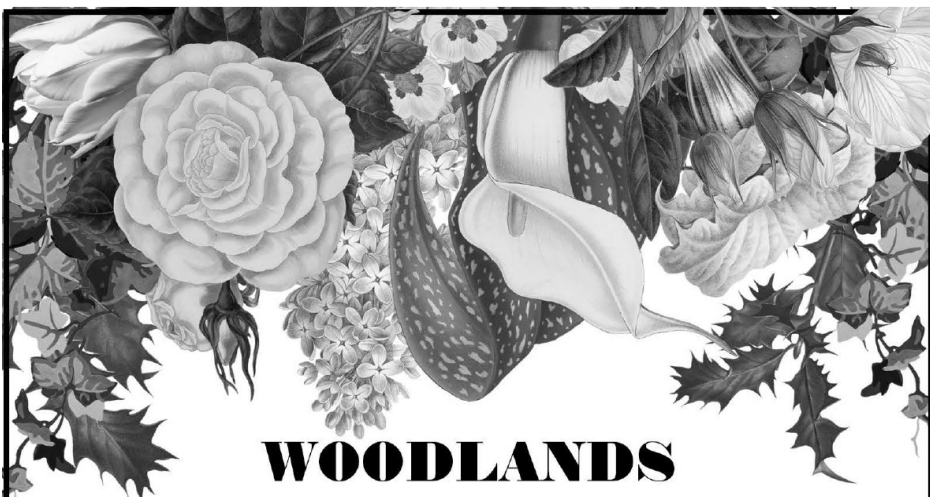

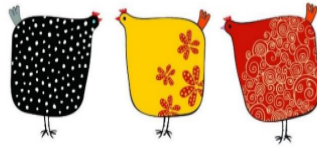
